Robins Federal Credit Union receives local awards

On May 20, the Better Business Bureau serving Central Georgia hosted its Torch Awards for Marketplace Ethics. Thirty-eight companies from Middle Georgia were nominated to receive the award. The award was granted based on outstanding high ethical standards of behavior toward customers, suppliers, employees, and the Middle Georgia community. Three awards were given, based on the size of the business.

Robins Federal Credit

Union won the Torch Award for Category III, which included companies with more than 100 employees. A total of nine companies, including Robins FCU, competed in Category III.

Entrants were rated by judges, which included two Better Business Bureau CEO's, in the categories of Management Practices, Communications and Investor/Stakeholder Relations, Communications and Marketing, and Industry Reputation. Robins FCU

received scores of nine and ten in each category.

In addition to the Torch Award, Robins FCU was also selected as an outstanding company in a local poll.

Robins Federal Credit Union was named Best of the Best for Financial Institutions in *The Macon Telegraph's* 2010 Best of the Best public poll. This is the third straight year that the Middle Georgia community has voted Robins FCU the best financial institution, bank or credit union, in all of Middle Georgia.
