TIC's new branch in Phenix City is now open

COLUMBUS, GA – TIC Federal Credit Union's first branch in Alabama is now open. The newly renovated facility is located on Highway 280 in Phenix City in front of Wal-Mart.

"The opening of our first Alabama branch is an exciting time in the history of our credit union," said Janet Davis, President and CEO. "We are proud to be able to offer even more convenience for our members who live in the Phenix City and Smiths Station communities. We are confident that our experience and service-based culture will resonate with citizens in the local communities."

TIC purchased the branch from Five Star Credit Union in September of last year. The branch had been closed so that it could be converted to TIC's innovative dialogue banking design. In addition to completely renovating the inside of the facility, the credit union also constructed a three-lane drive-thru with an ATM.

A grand opening ceremony will be held on Thursday, May 20 at 11 a.m. ET. Dignitaries from Phenix City, including Mayor Sonny Coulter, will attend.

The branch hours are Monday – Friday from 9:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. and on Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon. The drive-thru hours are 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. Monday - Friday and 9 a.m. to noon on Saturday.

The public is invited to drop by anytime during business hours for a cup of Starbuck's coffee and a tour of the branch.
