This is the 16th year GFCU has given the Vernon E. Carne Scholarship awards. Selection was based on academic accomplishments, leadership and participation in both school and community activities and an essay on how the credit union philosophy of 'people helping people' helps communities. This year's essay competition drew entries from 43 different high schools and the top winner was Shelly Anne Evans of Fayetteville, who received \$3,000. Second Place of \$2,000 was awarded to Carley Smith of Chatsworth. Third Place of \$1,000 was awarded to Alex Roe of Cumming.

The top scholarship award went to local student Shelly Anne Evans of Fayetteville. She attends Starr's Mill High School and plans to attend Georgia Tech and major in Management.
